Michael Diekmann is currently Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Allianz SE, having served as Chairman of the Board of Management and CEO from 2003 to 2015. He is also Vice Chairman of the Supervisory Board of BASF SE, Deputy Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Fresenius SE & Co. KGaA, and a member of the Supervisory Board of Siemens AG.

Mr Diekmann serves as Chairman of the International Business Leaders Advisory Council for the Mayor of Shanghai (IBLAC). He is a member of the Temasek European Advisory Panel, a member of the International Advisory Committee of the SINO CCE Fund of SINO-CEEFF Capital Management Company Ltd., and a member of the International Advisory Group of Linklaters LLP.

Michael Diekmann joined Allianz in 1988 and assumed various management positions within Allianz Germany. In 1996, he moved to Singapore to lead the Allianz Asia-Pacific region.

He joined the Allianz Management Board in 1998 with responsibility for Asia-Pacific, Central and Eastern Europe, the Middle East and Africa, together with the Group's human resources function. He was also part of the Company's International Executive Committee.

In 2002, he became Head of all Allianz insurance businesses in the Americas.
