



## Dr Jean-Louis Chaussade

### Current Positions

Jean-Louis Chaussade is Chairman of Suez, the world's leading environmental company dedicated to water and waste management, after having been its CEO for 15 years.

Mr Jean-Louis Chaussade was the CEO of Suez between 2004 and 2019. The Suez Group became public in 2008. Before, it was the environmental division of the "former" Suez Group (today Engie).

Jean-Louis Chaussade serves as a Non-Executive Board member of Kaufman & Broad SA and is a Director of Criteria Caixaholding SAU, Co-Chairman of the France-China Committee and a member of the Board of the Institut du Capitalisme Responsable (ICR).

### Background Information

Jean-Louis Chaussade joined Degrémont France in 1978, and became CEO of Degrémont Spain in 1989. He served as CEO of DUMEZ COPISA (Spain) from 1992 to 1997. Between 1997 and 2000, Mr Chaussade was CEO of Lyonnaise des Eaux Latin America and CEO of Aguas Argentinas. He was Vice President of EMOS (Santiago of Chile Water Company) between 1999 to 2000, and the Chairman and CEO of Degrémont between 2000 and 2004.

### Other Notable Interests

He has lived and worked eight years in Spain and three years in Argentina.

Mr Jean-Louis Chaussade is an Officier of the French Legion d'Honneur.
