He is a Board member of the Federation of Finnish Technology Industries and Futurice Corporation and a member of the European Roundtable of Industrialists (ERT) and The Global Tech Panel – launched by EU High Representative Federica Mogherini bringing together leaders from the tech industry, the world of investment, and civil society.

Mr Siilasmaa is a member of the Tsinghua SEM Advisory Board at Tsinghua University, a member of the International Advisory Board at IESE Business School, University of Navarra and a member of the Global Advisory Board of Yonsei University School of Business (YSB).
